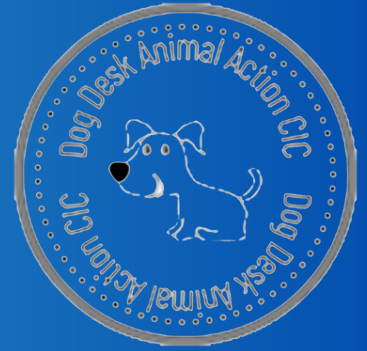
Don't allow your dog to breed. There are millions of unwanted dogs in the world, it's irresponsible to add to the population.

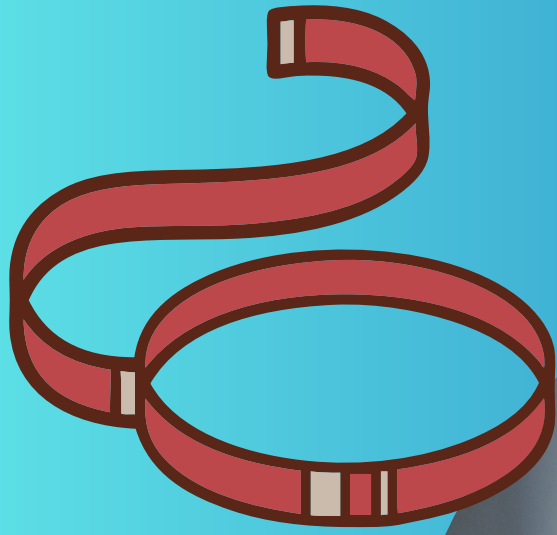
Train with your dog, teach them basic commands so they keep themselves & others safe

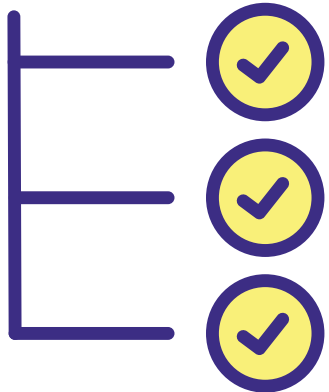
Remove plants from your garden that are poisonous to dogs.

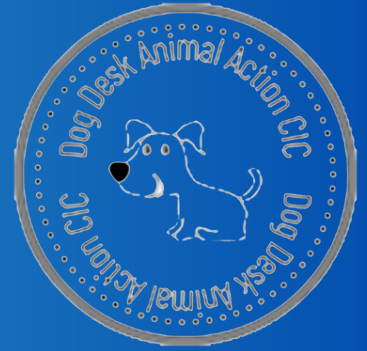

Regular grooming is important, coat, teeth, nails etc .

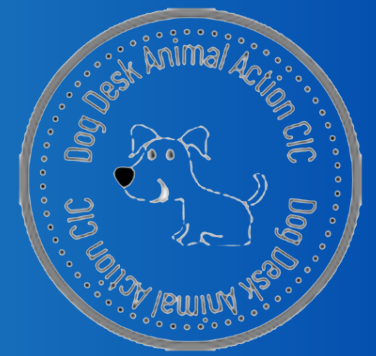
